

.PDF Set-up and Creation QuarkXpress

 Adobe Acrobat 4.0 to 5.0
 Adobe Postscript Driver 5.2 or higher for Windows

Overview

There are 3 steps to creating .pdf files for submission to Taylor Publishing.

1) Installation of System and Application files.

These files add additional functionality to your computer and configures your applications to produce a .pdf file that meet all of your printing needs.

2) Document Set-up and Preparation.

To create a .pdf file you must first set your document and all supporting files up correctly and then generate a .ps file that you will submit to Acrobat distiller.

3) Generation of .ps files and distilling them to .pdf files

Your document set-up and the method of writing a .ps file defines how Acrobat distiller will create your .pdf file.

Configuring Your Postscript Printer

To set your Windows computer up to create .pdf files for submission to Taylor you will need to install the following files on

your computer  Taylor PPD  TaylorSubmit.joboptions  TPC_Std_CMYK.icc

To install the  Taylor PPD drag the file to this location on your computer Your Computer/*c:WINNT/System32*. You must also install this in the following location for PageMaker6.5, PageMaker7.0, Indesign1.5, Indesign2.0 Your Computer/*C:/Programs/(Application)/RSRC/USEGLISH/PPD4*

To install the Adobe Acrobat Distiller Settings drag these files  TaylorSubmit.joboptions to the following location Your Computer/*C:/Programs/Adobe Acrobat (4.0 or 5.0)/Distiller/Settings*.

To install the  TPC_Std_CMYK.icc drag this file to the following location on your computer Your Computer/*WINNT/System32/Spool/Drivers/Color*

Installing the Adobe Postscript driver

Before you can install the Adobe Postscript driver you must first download it from Adobe's web site. Paste the following address into your browser's address bar and select Go.

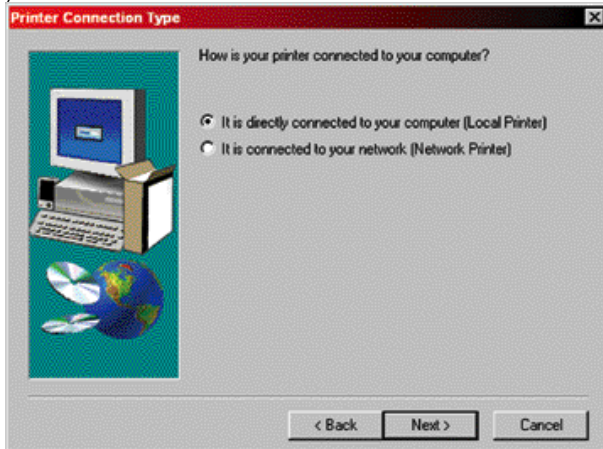
When the site comes up select the download button. Once the file has completed downloading double click the icon "winsteng.exe" and follow the instructions below.

1) In the first window follow the instructions in the "Welcome" window and select next

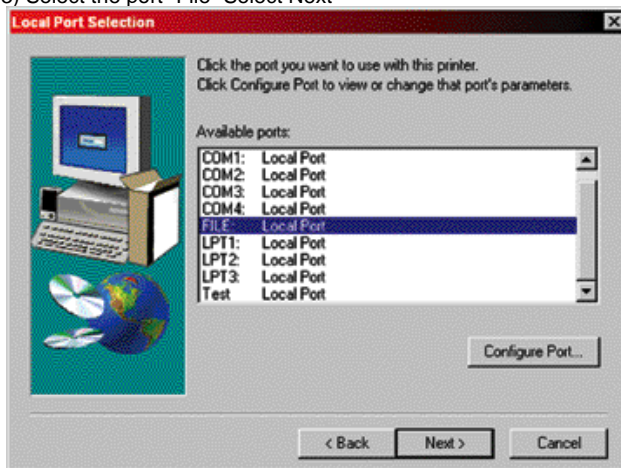


In the next window read the End User Licence Agreement and select "Accept" to install the driver.

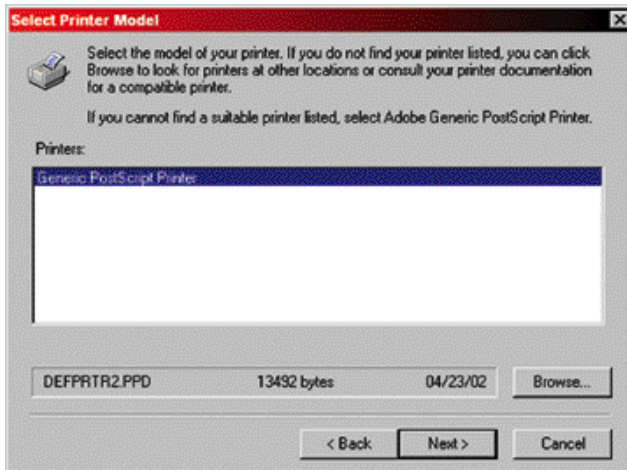
2) Select "Local Printer" Select Next



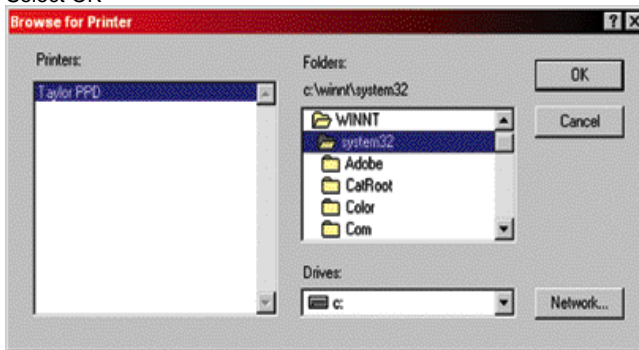
3) Select the port "File" Select Next



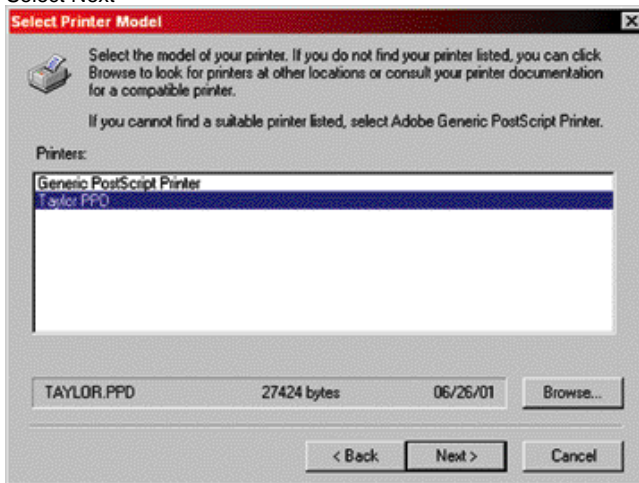
4) Select "Browse"



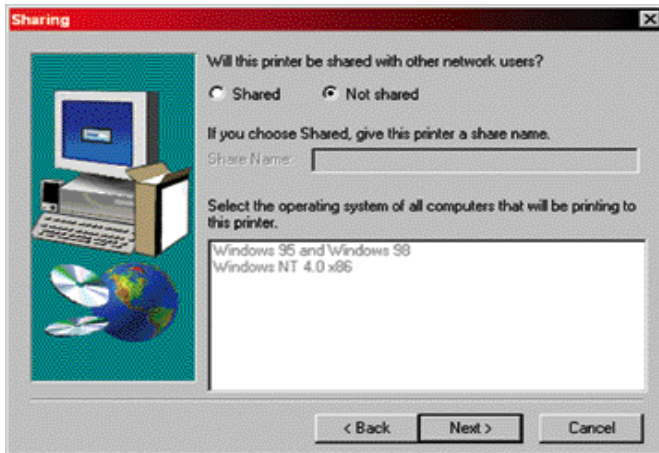
5) In the right hand window navigate to Drive:C:\WINNT\System32 and select Taylor PPD in the left hand window
Select OK



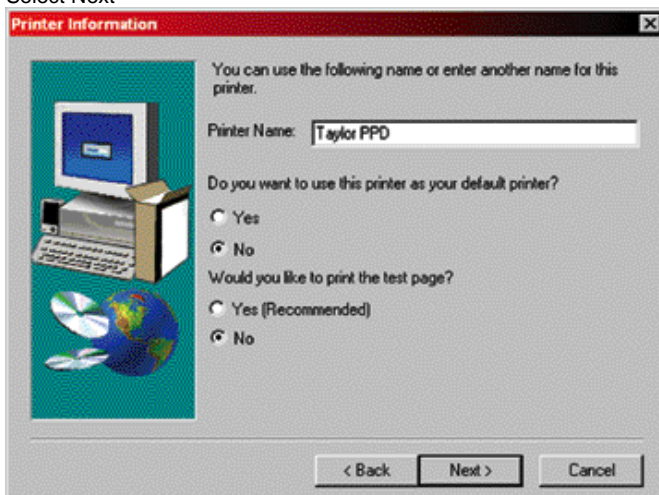
6) In the next window select Taylor PPD
Select Next



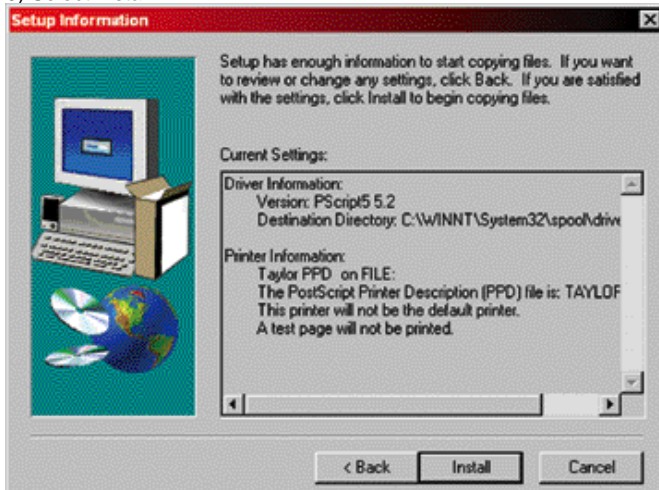
7) In the next window select "Not Shared"

Select Next



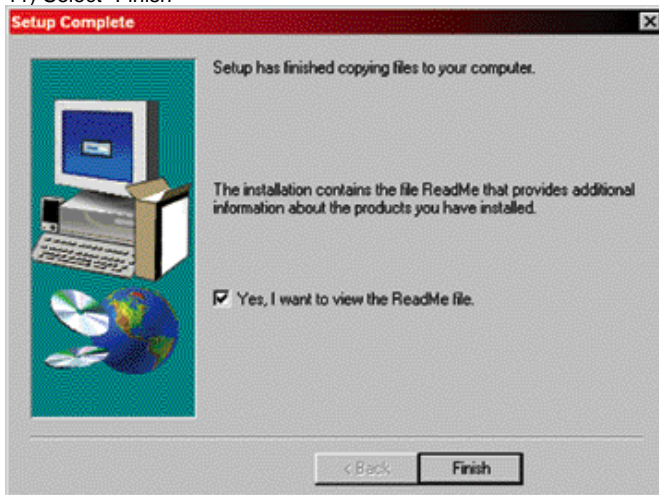
9) Select Install

11) Select "Finish"



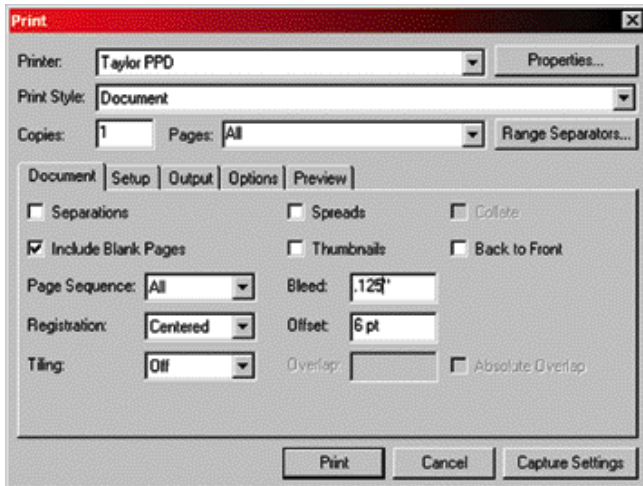
Document Set-up and Preparation for Windows

Some of the following windows will vary slightly if you are using windows 98/ME

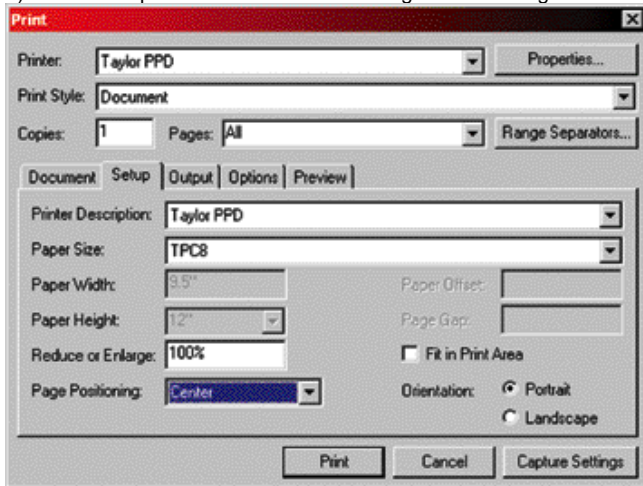
Quark Express

Some windows will vary on Windows 98/ME

- 1) Create a page document in one of the standard TPC page sizes. Name your file using the correct naming convention (ex: 12345_002_003)
- 2) Select File/Print and match all of the settings shown



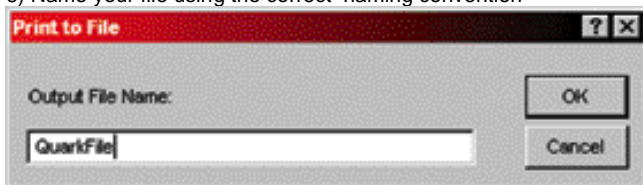
3) Select Setup and match all of the settings shown being sure to select the appropriate TPC page size



4) Save your document to a location where you will be able to locate it later as Quark will write your .ps file to this same location.

5) Select Print

6) Name your file using the correct naming convention

Distilling .ps files to create .pdf files

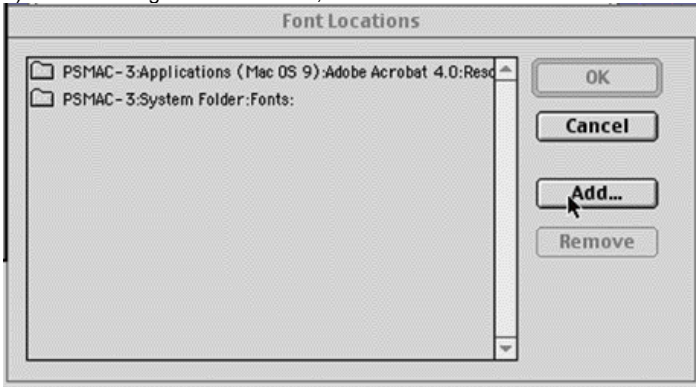
Acrobat Distiller 4.0 and 5.0

Macintosh and Windows

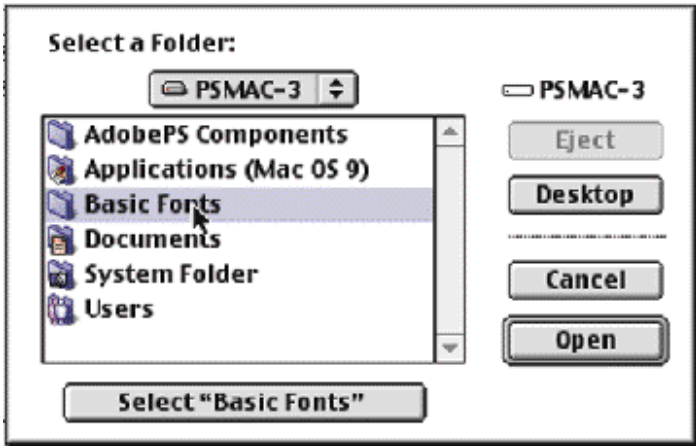
Once you have written your .ps files you are now ready to create your .pdf's.

1) Launch Adobe Acrobat Distiller

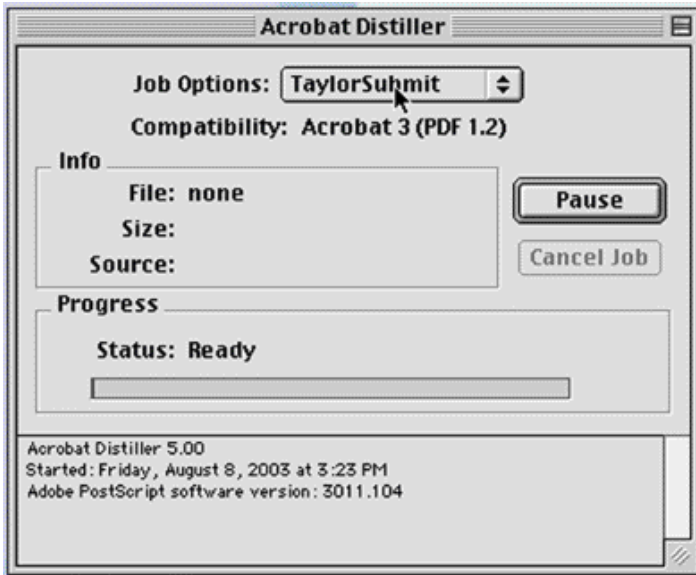
2) Select Settings/Font Locations, select Add



3) Navigate to your job's font folder, Select the lower bar "Select"



4) Select "TaylorSubmit"



5) Drag the .ps files from the location you wrote them to onto the Distiller window. Your .pdf files will automatically save themselves to the same file your .ps files came from
